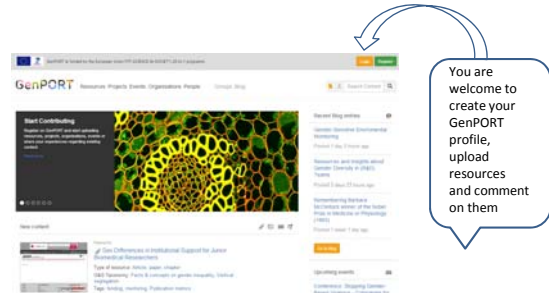

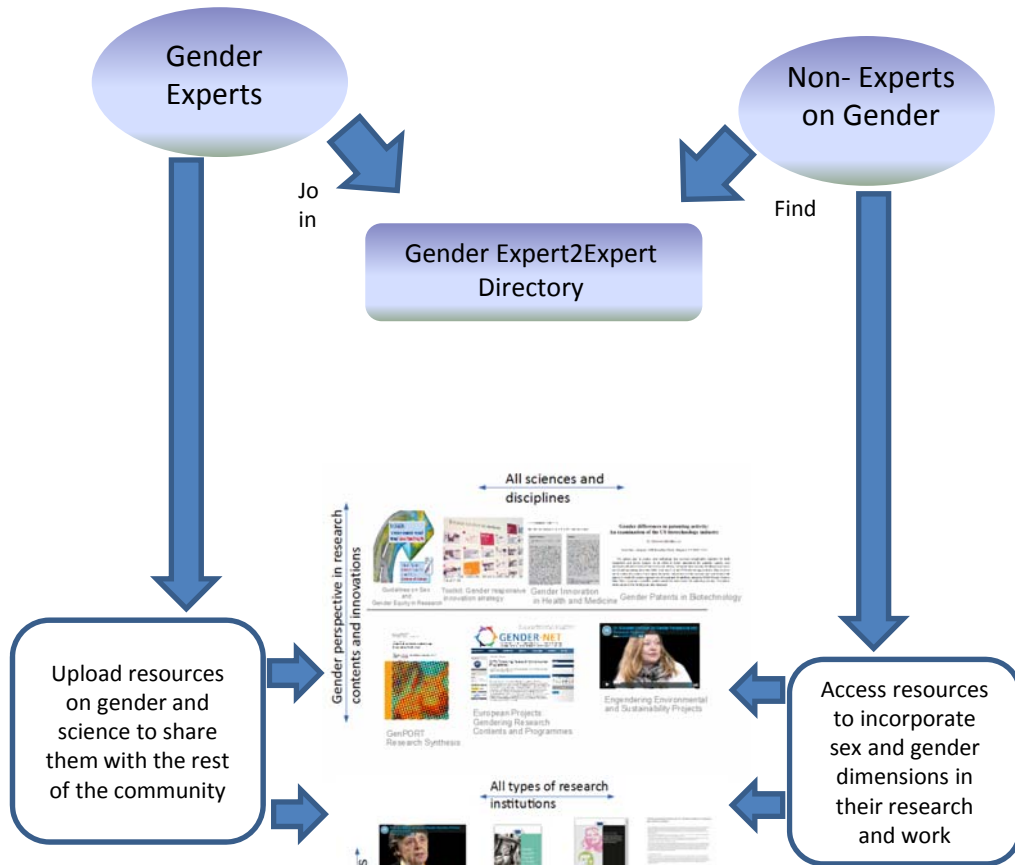
What is GenPORT?

GenPORT (<http://www.genderportal.eu>) is a community working across the globe for gender equality and excellence in science, technology or innovation.

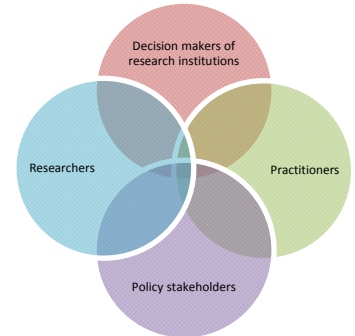
This covers all sciences – natural and social sciences, and humanities.
